	<p>The dogs can be entered to FCI-CACIL class or CSS class.</p> <p>Transitional measure: To enter the FCI-CACIL class before December 31st, 2022 – dogs that don't have FCI-CACIL license yet must send a report from the dog show along with the coursing entry. It is necessary to submit one report from an international FCI-CACIB dog show with at least „very good“ from class: intermediate, open, working or champion.</p> <p>FCI group V Only CSS class Pharaon Hound, Cirneco dell'Etna, Podenco Ibicenco, Podenco Canario</p>
Registration, veterinary check:	7:00 – 8:00 AM
Start of the race:	8:30 am
End of the race, ceremony:	Saturday: 6:00 PM
Track length:	600 – 800 m
Track type and surface	Natural terrain, grass, pasture
Technique of pulling the lure:	Motor reel, closed circuit over pulleys
Conditions of participation:	<p>According to FCI Regulations for International Lure Coursing Events, each dog entered to race must have a valid racing or coursing license. The muzzle is mandatory for all breeds.</p> <p>All competitors must strictly follow the race schedule, so the trouble-free progress of the race can be ensured. The FCI judging system is used.</p>
Mandatory equipment for dogs:	The dog will run in racing jackets in red and white colour without numbers or any other signs . The muzzles are mandatory for all breeds!
Organization of runs:	<p>The selection of pairs of dogs for the first heat is made by random selection. In case of an uneven number of entries, the organizers will try to find a companion dog with a license to pair run where possible to avoid a solo run.</p> <p>If there is an uneven number of dogs in both genders or classes, female and male, which could otherwise run solo, will run together.</p> <p>In the second heat, the dogs will be arranged in pairs based on the first heat results (1+2, 3+4, etc.). The pairs will run in random order then.</p>
Protest:	The protesting person must pay the race organiser a

	<p>fee of 100 EUR, and the organiser will pay the fee back if the protest is legitimate and justified. The Lure Coursing Director and the judges are authorised to reject the protest.</p> <p>The organiser will write a Coursing report about the race and send it to the Coursing Committee with the protest description and its solution/results. It is not possible to enter a protest against the judges' decisions.</p>

Veterinary conditions:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Every dog on the start must have a valid passport or a veterinary certificate and must be clinically healthy. 2. Every dog on the start must have a valid vaccination against rabies not less than 21 days before coursing and not longer than the producer's stated validity for the used rabies vaccination. 3. Every dog must have valid vaccination for distemper, parvoviruses, leptospirosis, and contagious liver inflammation not less than 21 days and not more than 1 year before coursing. 4. Dogs older than 6 years and dogs younger than 2 years must pass the veterinary check before the second round. 5. Every dog on the start must be unmistakably marked by microchip. Marking of a microchip must be according norm ISO 11784 and microchip is possible control by reading device according norm ISO 11785. <p>The dog's owner is obliged to take care of the actual condition of the dog and set the dog's performance appropriately. There is always an opportunity to withdraw the dog from the coursing.</p>
Responsibility disclaimer	<p>Neither the organiser nor the officials are responsible for injuries incurred by the dog owners, the dogs or the officials. Likewise, they accept no responsibility for escaped/lost dogs.</p> <p>A dog owner is not responsible if his dog injures another dog during the race. In all other cases, the dog's owner has full responsibility for the dog.</p>
Dope testing:	All kinds of doping are forbidden. The doping test follows § 1.9 FCI International race and coursing regulations and the National coursing rules of Slovakia.
Misconduct by owners or handlers:	<p>All the dog owners/handlers must behave according to the following rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not let the dog free of the leash. • Do not cause property damage or material damage.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eventually, do not interfere with the course of the race. <p>The owner/handler whose dog breached one of these rules can be charged with a financial penalty 25 EUR. The Lure Coursing Director and the judges are authorised to exclude and dismiss anyone from the race/event who does not follow the race officials' instructions, insults them, or behaves improperly without any fee's refund.</p>
