Conditions of participation:	<p>According to FCI Regulations for International Lure Coursing Events, each dog entered to race must have a valid racing or coursing license. The muzzle is mandatory for all breeds.</p> <p>All competitors must strictly follow the race schedule to ensure a trouble-free race. The FCI judging system is used.</p>
Mandatory equipment for dogs:	The dog will run in racing jackets in red and white colour without numbers or any other signs . The muzzles are mandatory for all breeds!
Organisation of runs:	<p>The selection of pairs of dogs for the first heat is random. In cases where the number of entries is uneven, the organisers will, where possible, pair run with a licensed companion dog to avoid a solo run.</p> <p>If there is an uneven number of dogs in both genders or classes, female and male, which could otherwise run solo, will run together.</p> <p>In the second heat, the dogs will be arranged in pairs based on the first heat results (1+2, 3+4, etc.). The pairs will run in random order then.</p>
Protest:	<p>A competitor has the right to file a protest during the race, upon payment of a 100 EUR deposit. It is not possible to lodge a protest against the judges' decisions. The organiser will pay the fee back if the protest is legitimate and justified. The Lure Coursing Director and the judges are authorised to reject the protest.</p> <p>All protests and their outcomes will be included in the official coursing report sent to the Coursing Committee</p>

Veterinary conditions:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Dogs arriving at the competition must have a pet passport or veterinary certificate and must be clinically healthy. 2. Dogs must be vaccinated against rabies not less than 21 days before the event and not beyond the validity period specified by the vaccine manufacturer's vaccination schedule.



	<p>3. Dogs must have a PET PASSPORT.</p> <p>4. Dogs older than 6 years and younger than 2 years must undergo a second veterinary check, which will take place after the first round.</p> <p>5. Dogs must be unmistakably identified by a microchip. The microchip used to identify the dog must comply with ISO standard 11784 and must be readable by a device compliant with ISO standard 11785.</p> <p>The dog owner is obliged to consider the dog's current condition and only subject the animal to an appropriate level of exertion. Therefore, the owner always has the option to withdraw their dog from the coursing.</p>
Responsibility disclaimer	<p>Neither the organiser nor the officials is responsible for injuries incurred by the dog owners, the dogs, or the officials. Likewise, they accept no responsibility for escaped dogs. The dog owner is responsible for the dog at all times.</p> <p>§ 1.10 Responsibility disclaimer - FCI Regulations for International Sighthound Racing and Lure Coursing Events</p>
Doping:	<p>All forms of doping are prohibited. The doping test complies with § 1.9 of the FCI International race and coursing regulations and the National coursing rules of Slovakia.</p>
Misconduct by owners or handlers:	<p>All the dog owners/handlers must behave according to the following rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep dogs leashed at all times • Avoid property or material damage • Eventually, do not interfere with the course of the race. <p>The owner/handler whose dog breached one of these rules can be charged with a financial penalty 50 EUR. The Lure Coursing Director and the judges are authorised to exclude and dismiss anyone from the race/event who does not follow the race officials' instructions, insults them, or behaves improperly without any fee refund.</p>
